**Please note:** Cost of tuition for full-time study in Calvin Theological Seminary's MDiv program is approximately **\$16,467.00**.

At our October 2012 meeting, Classis decided to return to past precedent and cap all student assistance at 50% of the tuition costs of each student. The mandate of Classis in recent years has also been to limit the Student Fund's total annual disbursement to approximately \$30,000.00.
